How the Big Four Ranked in the 1Q23 IPO Market

Following the US IPO market's slowest year in decades, the first quarter of 2023 continued the trend with 29 IPOs raising just \$2.3 billion. Deal flow started at a decent pace but failed to pick back up after the February lull, as hawkish signals from the Fed, renewed recession fears, and turmoil within the banking industry caused a spike in volatility. The Big Four accounting firms appeared on the ten largest IPOs of the quarter, representing 90% of the quarter's proceeds but just 34% of total deal count due to a wave of micro-caps. With every offering requiring audited financials, there were 29 auditing engagements with 17 accounting firms, or 40 with 21 accounting firms, including SPACs.

Ernst & Young was the most active IPO auditor in the first quarter, working on just three IPOs that raised \$650 million. Its clients all came from different sectors and included the quarter's second-largest offering, frac sand miner Atlas Energy, followed by hypertension biotech Mineralys Therapeutics and property and casualty insurer Skyward Specialty. Coming up, EY is on two sizable IPOs in the active pipeline, Vietnamese EV developer VinFast Auto, and Chinese vet clinic New Ruipeng Pet Group.

Last September, EY's leadership decided to move forward with a vote to split the company and publicly list its advisory practice, but in March it was reported that the deal was in jeopardy over a dispute among some senior staff members. While the firm had reportedly believed other Big Four members would mirror the proposed move, Deloitte recently shared a video of its Global CEO affirming no plans to split.
